Quincy Medical Center Appoints Neurology Chief

Dr. Anil Nair has been named chief of neurology at Quincy Medical Center.

Nair has been on staff at Quincy Medical since 2007 and is certified in neurology by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology with a subspecialty in geriatric neurology. He is an assistant professor of neurology at Boston University School of Medicine.

His research interests center on neurocognitive disorders in seniors, including early and pre-clinical detection, treatment and prevention of Alzheimer's disease. He has experience as a clinical investigator and has served as principal investigator for several Alzheimer's disease clinical trials at Boston University and will be continuing his research QMC.

Opening to patients in July, the Alzheimer's Disease Center at Quincy Medical Center is a multidisciplinary clinical and research center, providing care in geriatric neurology, Alzheimer's disease and other neurocognitive disorders. As a "green" paperless office, the Alzheimer's Disease Center will offer patients and family members the option to schedule appointments online. The center also utilizes the latest HIPPA compliant technology for secure electronic charting and is piloting technology that allows memory-impaired patients and their families to receive automatic appointment reminders by phone, text message or email.

Nair completed a fellowship in geriatric behavioral neurology at the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine in, Rochester, Minn., and his neurology residency at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation in Cleveland. He completed his internship and internal medicine residency at the Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research in Pondicherry, India, and is a graduate of the Mahatma Gandhi University in

Kerala, India.

He is an executive board member of the Massachusetts Neurological Association, and serves on many national medical and academic committees. He is a member of the American Academy of Neurology, Massachusetts Neurological Association and the Massachusetts Medical Society. He sits on the editorial boards of numerous medical journals and his works have been published extensively.

Nair is involved in teaching medical students and residents via lectures and direct patient care in the inpatient and outpatient settings. His honors and awards include the Palatucci Advocacy Leadership Award from the American Academy of Neurology.
